

Yale Lockmaster

We have changed our Residential, French & Composite Door locks to Yale 'Lockmaster'. The changeover has applied to most doors delivered on or after 2nd September 2015. There are some key points for consideration on each door type.

Residential Door Specification:

Top & bottom hook with anti-lift bolts (underneath each hook), 4 rollers, centre hook and latch with a one-piece keep.

The lock type changes to 2 rollers on doors below 1979mm (this height includes a 72mm thresh & 150mm cill)

French Door Specification:

Top & bottom hook with anti-lift bolts (underneath each hook), 4 rollers, centre hook and latch with a one-piece keep.

The lock type changes to 2 rollers on doors below 1979mm (this height includes a 72mm thresh & 150mm cill)

Both the master & slave doors have shoot-bolts top & bottom

Please note on smaller height doors you will only receive a shoot-bolt on the slave door (no shoot-bolt to master door) see table below.

Composite Doors:

3 Hooks (top, middle, & bottom) & 3 separate keeps

The maximum guaranteed height of any Residential & French Doors remains 2230mm including external cill.
