To maintain the pristine look of your new door please observe these simple instructions:

Cleaning your door every 4-6 weeks

Part of the door	Cleaning	Finishing
Door Leaf	Keep the grime & grit away with a warm damp cloth (do not use washing up liquid) dry with a micro-fibre cloth.	
Door Frame	Wash with warm soapy water with a soft cloth	Stubborn stains will demand specialised PVC-U cleaner (<i>not to be used on the painted door leaf</i>)
External Glass	Wash with warm soapy water with a soft cloth	Finish with a proprietary glass cleaner
Leaded Glass	Wash with warm soapy water with a soft cloth	Finish with a proprietary glass cleaner (<i>some oxidation may naturally occur</i>)
Hardware (handles knockers & L/Box)	Wash with warm soapy water with a soft cloth	Use a micro-fibre cloth to shine

CAUTION! DO NOT USE

Washing up liquid or detergents, abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. High pressure or steam cleaners. Bleach Solvents (spirits or thinners) or adhesives.

Before cleaning your door remove all jewellery including watches to avoid scratches.

Maintain your door every 6 months

Part of the door	Recommended Maintenance	Notes
Hinges	Keep them at their best by lubricating with a little light engineering oil e.g. 3 in 1	
Euro Cylinder Locks (where you put the key)	Graphite Powder	Do not use oil
Hardware (handles knockers)	Just add a touch of engineering oil on all moving parts	Especially important if you live near the coast or by a building or industrial site

IMPORTANT!

Protect your door from natural thermal distortion. Make Sure the top & bottom hook-bolt locks are engaged by pulling the handle up every time you shut the door.
